**Subject:-** Essentiality Certificate/NOC for MDS in Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge, Periodontology, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics, Orthodontics and Dentofacial orthopedics, pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry, Oral Pathology and Microbiology, Public Health Dentistry, Oral Medicine and Radiology – Genesis Institute of Dental Sciences and Research, Ferozepur.

Reference on the subject cited above.

The desired certificate is as follows:-

- (1) No. of Institutions already existing in the State – BDS – 11, MDS-6
- (2) No. of seats available or No. of Dental Surgeons being produced annually–BDS-800, MDS-57.
- (3) No. of Dental Surgeons registered with the State Dental Council – 3604 (as on 31.12.2003).
- (4) No. of Dental Surgeons in Government services - 220
- (5) No. of Government posts vacant and those in rural/difficult areas - 82
- (6) No. of dental surgeons registered with Employment Exchange - Nil
- (7) Dental Surgeon population ratio in the State – 1:7000 (As per registered figures), Punjab 2001 population being – 2, 42, 89, 296
- (8) How the establishment of the college would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified dental personnel in the State and improve the availability of such dental manpower in the State – The ratio as per the no. of MDS registered with the Punjab Dental Council on the face of it appears to be alright but the real existing ratio is much high i.e. no. of Dentists is much less. A large number of Dentist have gone abroad. In fact most of the vacancies in Govt. Hospitals are vacant due to migration abroad. There is a lot of demand for this course in the state.
- (9) The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State, be specified – The State permits 15% quota for the CBSE students. The students from Punjab have preferential rights of admission and students from other states are allowed admission only if students from Punjab are not available.
- (10) Full justification for opening of the proposed college – There are 4 strong reasons for allowing permission to this Society for starting MDS course (1) The number of Dental Surgeons is much less as compared to the figures of Dental Council as explained above. (2) There is unemployment in the state and students prefer professional, Medical & Dental Courses so that their chances of immigration to other countries are enhanced. Resultantly there is a huge demand for this course in the state. (3) The College is proposed to be located in the city of Ferozepur which is about 9 km from the Pakistan Border. Punjab shares about 500 KM length of border with Pakistan and there are only 2 other Dental Colleges (in Amritsar city at a distance of 120 KM from Ferozepur). Punjab Govt. provides reservation of 1% for students of these 3 border districts in medical and professional colleges. Besides Ferozepur has also been classified as Backward Area for the students of which 1% reservation is separately provided. The State Govt. feels that more colleges and institutions should come up in Border and Backward areas of the State. (4) The Society is running BDS College for 100 seats since 2005. The State is producing 800 BDS Graduates, however it has only 57 MDS-seats. So there is great need for MDS seats in the State.
- (11) Dental Surgeon -patient ratio proposed to be achieved -- 1: 7000
- (12) Copy of the Inspection Report in connection with the Inspection carried out by the State Government for grant of permission for setting up to start MDS Course with six seats in each



speciality is to be attached - Enclosed herewith. The Secretary, Shaheed Dr. Anil Baghi Charitable Society, Anil Baghi Road, Ferozepur has applied for starting of MDS Course.

On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government agree to issue an Essentiality Certificate/NOC for starting of MDS Course for 54 seats in Nine specialties 6 seats in each specialty at Ferozepur to the following specialties:-

"(i) Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge (ii) Periodontology (iii) Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery (iv) Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics (v) Orthodontics and Dentofacial orthopedics, (vi) pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry, (vii) Oral Pathology and Microbiology, (viii) Public Health Dentistry, (ix) Oral Medicine and Radiology."

2. It is certified that:-

- a) The applicant owns and manages a 100 bedded hospital which was established in 1984.
- b) The applicants own and manage a dental hospital. Yes
- c) It is desirable to establish a MDS course in the dental college in the public interest.
- d) Establishment of a dental College - The Secretary, Shaheed Dr. Anil Baghi Charitable Society, Anil Baghi Road, Ferozepur (Punjab).
- e) Minimum 150 OPD Dental patients per day are available to begin with.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the dental college as per Dental Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Dental Council of India, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.

3. Conditions:-

The Essentiality Certificate is granted with the following conditions:-

- i) All the documents as asked for vide Government letter referred to above would be supplied by the Society well before making the admissions.
- ii) The Institute will obtain recognition from the Dental Council of India, New Delhi/concerned University before making admissions.
- iii) No admission shall be made without the prior approval of Punjab Government for which the Institute will request the State Government.
- iv) The admissions shall be done as per criteria fixed by Punjab Govt. time to time.
- v) The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government instructions issued from time to time.
- vi) The pay scales and emoluments of their staff shall be as per Punjab Government pay scales.
- vii) The inspection of the institute shall be carried out on yearly basis upto the completion of the study of first batch of the students. Thereafter, the inspection shall be periodical after three years.
- viii) The project is to be implemented as per the approved project report within the prescribed time.
- ix) The Punjab Government will have the right to withdraw the N.O.C. if the Society/applicant fails to meet any of the conditions of NOC.
- x) The construction work shall be completed within one year and admission shall be made within 2 years of the issue of NOC.




